



Players Code of Conduct



- Players will only be able to attend training/matches once their term/monthly and registration fees have been paid in full and training kit has been issued
- Players must wear the correct footwear, protective shin guards and full kit to all training sessions. Failure to which will result in the player not participating in the session. Additional training kit can be purchased at an additional cost (shorts, shirts, socks) please see a member of coaching staff for details
- Players must wear the correct footwear, protective shin guards and full kit to all matches. Failure to which will result in the player not participating in the match
- Players are required to act within the spirit of good sportsmanship and abide by the 'Laws of the game'. Players must respect coaching staff and match officials along with other club officials at all times while attending training or matches
- Players are required to be punctual to training and games at all times. Also display & promote high standards of behaviour and promote fair play. Never to engage in bullying, harassment or intimidation
- Greet every member of staff & team mates at training or matches by shaking hands with them
- Listen fully to the coaches' instructions and do not be scared to ask if you do not understand, coaches are there to help and educate you so they will explain for you to understand. Failure to do so will result in your poor development. Players must have enthusiasm towards all training sessions and games
- Always help with training equipment at the beginning and end of training or games, have full respect for the facility and equipment you are using
- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team and not one individual player
- Talk to someone I trust if I'm unhappy about anything at the academy

Failure to comply/adhere with the above may result in the player/parent being asked to leave the training session, match or academy
